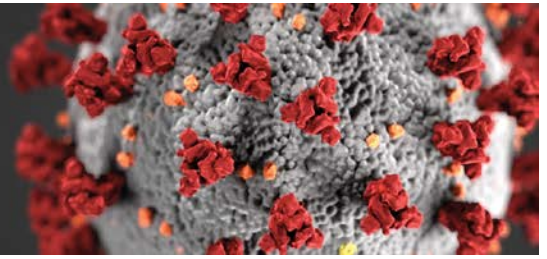


COVID-19



Donations of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

As Asante continues to prepare for the spread of COVID-19 in Southern Oregon, we are working to obtain much-needed Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that our frontline clinical caregivers use to keep patients safe. We welcome all donations of the following in support of this effort:

- N95 masks, both new and used
- Protective face shields
- Elastomeric masks (a type of reusable N95 mask)
- General ISO masks/paper masks
- Isolation gowns (disposable or reusable)
- Latex-free (i.e. Nitrile) exam gloves in all sizes
- Disposable head covers/bonnets
- Eye protection glasses or goggles

This equipment is critical for the protection of bedside caregivers and patients. Donations can be dropped off at Asante Foundation located at 229 N.
